

Anchor Fund FAQs

1. What is the Anchor Fund?

a. The Anchor Fund is the Diocese of Christ Our Hope's yearly effort to build capacity for kingdom mission. There are a variety of mission and ministry initiatives outside of our church planting work that we have the people and passion for, but not the financial capacity. The Anchor Fund is an opportunity for the people of the diocese to partner with us to raise money to fund these initiatives. The key Anchor Fund event is the Anchor Fund Offering in which each church takes up a special offering on two Sundays during Eastertide.

2. What is the Anchor Fund Offering??

a. Each church will hold a special Anchor Fund Offering on two Sundays during Eastertide. We ask each adult to give a one-time gift of \$50 above and beyond their usual tithing to their local church. We want to include everyone in the life and mission of the diocese, so we are asking teens (ages 13-19) to consider giving a one-time gift of \$25, as well.

3. Can I give to a particular Initiative?

a. Yes. Individuals can choose to give to a particular initiative that they are interested in or passionate about, or they can give to the Anchor Fund general fund and let the diocese determine where to designate their gift.

4. How do I give to the Anchor Fund?

- a. Online giving is the preferred method. Gifts can be given online at <u>www.adhope.org/anchor-fund</u>. When giving online individuals can select the initiative they would like to give to.
- **b.** Gifts can also be given by check. Write "Anchor Fund [preferred initiative]" on the memo line. Checks should be made out to:
