GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Church of the Lamb is an Anglican church in Rockingham County, VA. Our community desires to abide as disciples of Christ: invited to rest and compelled to love. We seek a part-time employee to nurture our children (ages 3–12) as they grow up in the Church.

QUALIFICATIONS

The ideal applicant:

- Loves God, has a robust devotional life, takes prayer seriously, and has a heart for worship, including worship in the Anglican tradition.
- Loves God's people and God's Church.
- Loves unreached, disconnected, and marginalized people, having a heart for evangelism and mission.
- Beliefs are consistent with those described in the Articles of Religion and the Jerusalem Declaration.
- Has skill and strong interest in discipleship beyond Sunday services.
- Is humble, warm, hospitable, flexible, and loyal.
- Desires to know and be known by others.
- Has strong relational skills: people want to follow him/her.

- Is a confident self-starter with a strong work ethic. Is willing to lead people into something new.
- Demonstrates the potential for leadership: ability to build and lead teams to accomplish goals, ability to delegate, ability to see the big picture and cast vision.
- Can love and understand the communities of Rockingham County and Harrisonburg.
- Is willing to be trained (or already is trained) in 3 levels of Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) over a reasonable amount of time.
- Desires to use a Montessori-based approach to guide children as they grow in practical life skills, grasp Scripture and liturgy, and experience prayer and worship.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Lead Children's Ministry at Lamb**
 - Implement CGS, currently for ages 3–6, eventually for children ages 3–12.
 - Attend all CGS trainings within a reasonable amount of time.
 - Maintain the level 1 atrium (space for children's worship).
 - Create and develop the level 2 and level 3 atria.
 - Provide resources for spiritual growth for children ages 7–12 in the interim period until we have level 2 and level 3 atria.
 - Coordinate and oversee all logistics and materials related to CGS.
- **Oversee all Children's Volunteers**
 - Pray for, recruit, schedule, remind, oversee, and thank children's ministry volunteers.
 - Maintain and enforce Church of the Lamb's child safety policy. Attend and conduct MinistrySafe trainings.
- **Develop Spiritual Formation Tools for Families**
 - Develop and offer tools for parents to help their families grow spiritually in the home.
 - Build relationships with parents and children in and outside of Sunday morning worship.
- **Attend staff meetings once per month.**
- **Additional responsibilities as assigned by the Rector.**
