





The Diocese of Christ Our Hope saw record increases in the number of people being ordained, especially deacons.






Confirmations & Ordinations

Convocation, Consecration & Synod

Over 200 delegates gathered at Church of the Redeemer in Greensboro, NC on November 4-6, 2021 for our annual Convocation and Synod and the consecration of The Right. Rev. Alan Hawkins as bishop coadjutor. Over 450 attended the consecration.



Thursday and Friday's Convocation was titled **This is My Body: Jesus, Bodies, and the Sacraments.** We were joined by Dr. Marc Cortez and Dr. Julie Canliss who focused on the question of what it means to be human.

Friday evening's consecration was a joyous time of worship! Over 10 bishops from both the ACNA and Rwanda were in attendance along with over 450 people from around the ACNA!

Synod concluded events on Saturday morning. Reports were presented and received, and the business of the diocese was conducted effectively and joyfully.


